Panels & Mouldings

All our panels and mouldings are bespoke made and can be produced to each of our customer's requirements. The material used for the external panel is Medite Tricoya Extreme, a ground breaking material which exhibits outstanding durability and dimensional stability.

It is a very resilient and moisture resistant material so you can be certain that there will be no movement, cracking or warping over time, like you often see in wooden doors.

Another benefit of this material is that it is perfectly flat which is ideal in producing the opulent high gloss finish, available in any coloured lacquer.

For a real-wood effect we use an Okoume panel which has similar benefits including moisture resistance, and can be stained to a colour of your choice. Alternatively solid wood panels can be used.

Finises

For lacquered and high gloss finishes, a hard wearing and durable lacquer is applied to create an exceptionally smooth finish on your door in any RAL colour of your choice. We can also colour match other brands such as Farrow & Ball and Little Green.

The lacquer is extremely durable and is offered in satin (25% gloss), or high gloss (100%).

Our signature high gloss finish is hand polished and takes up to 24 hours to achieve the piano finish we are renowned for.

We can also produce doors in liquid metal finishes which is applied gradually by hand in layers to create an impressive texture. The door leaf and frame are finished with a zinc primer then powder coated to prolong the application and lifespan while withstanding the harshest of conditions such as coastal locations or those subject to severe weather conditions.

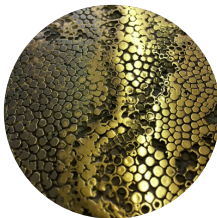

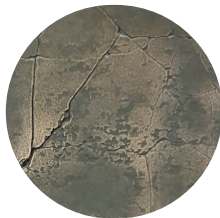

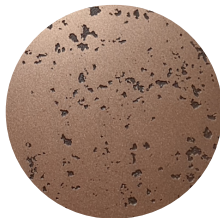

Glass Types

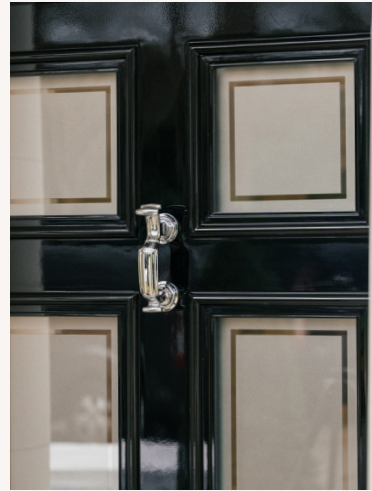
Your new door can be created as a single or double set and with glazed panels within the door, side panels or a fan light. The glazing can include lettering or numbering, and come in either clear, opaque or one-way mirror glass. The glass is a triple glazed security glass, 44mm thick.



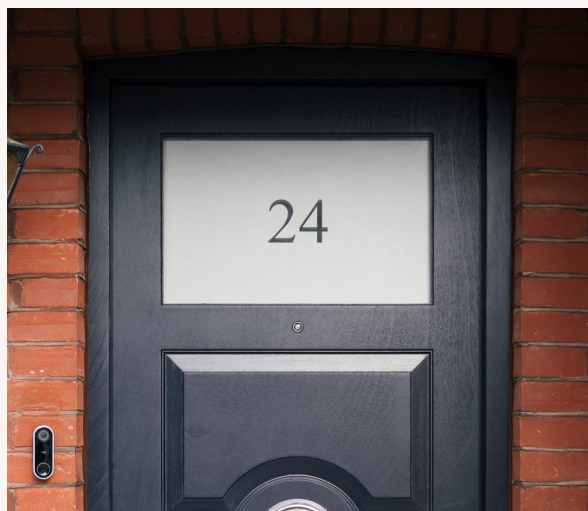

Lock & Automated Upgrades

Our doors come with a multipoint locking system as standard, which can be upgraded to a motorised lock giving you the convenience of electronically opening your door with the use of either a fob reader, electronic keypad, fingerprint scanner or with a mobile app. The motorised lock can also be linked to your home control system.

Level 3

As standard we supply a Level 3 security door which has 10 bolts between the door and frame.

Overview:

- Total door thickness 75mm
- Resistant to most burglary tools including crow bars
- 100% thermal insulation by 50mm rock wool
- Sound insulation of 4dB

Level 4

Upgrade to Level 4 security and your door will have 16 contact points between the door and frame, with the option to add bullet proof systems.

Overview:

- Total door thickness 91mm
- Resistant to most burglary tools including crow bars and powered drilling tools
- 100% double thermal insulation: a 30mm layer of rock wool on both sides of the steel sheet (60mm total)
- Sound insulation of 45dB



For our security conscious clientele, we offer further reassurance by upgrading to a bulletproof door, which can match existing decor or period finishes and features. We use engineered materials such as steel, glass and wood in various fabrications and in a variety of shapes and sizes to incorporate the design aesthetic into our client's security solution.

High security doors have all the benefits of a timber door plus many more; they offer burglary resistance, noise reduction and wind insulation. The inside of the door is insulated with rockwool giving excellent U-values of 1.3 and sound insulation up to 45dB, as well as dual weather stripping, low-level thresholds and high-performance ball bearing welded butt hinges. Concealed hinges are also available upon request. We can produce doors as large as 4000mm x 2000mm for a single leaf.

CNC machining is a manufacturing process where you pre-programme the machine with computer software which tells the machine how to move the tools and machinery. It allows 3D cutting tasks to

be achieved with an instruction from the human operators to the machine. CNC machining enables the standards to be maximised to produce any bespoke design from our customer's request. With a large range of design options available with our knowledge we can offer advice on the best materials for your project.

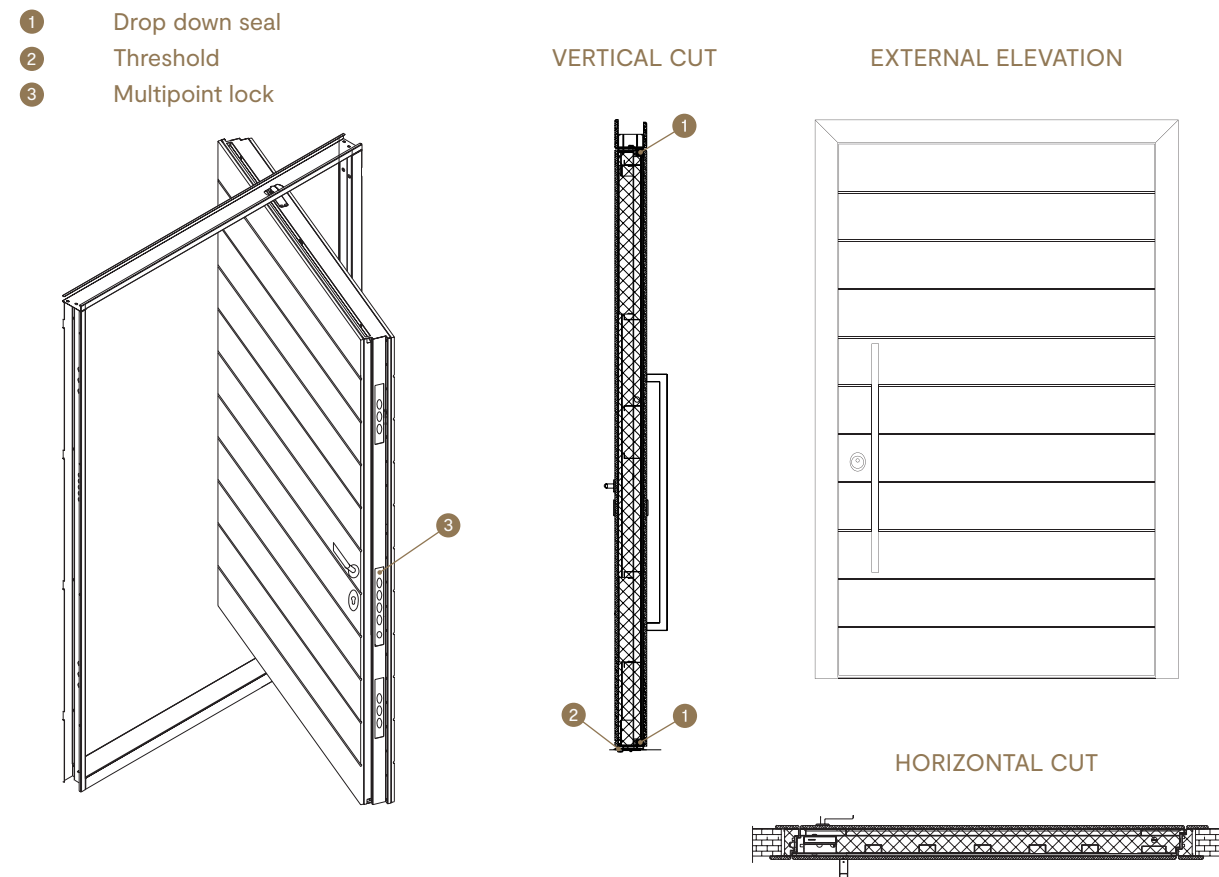


Pivot Doors

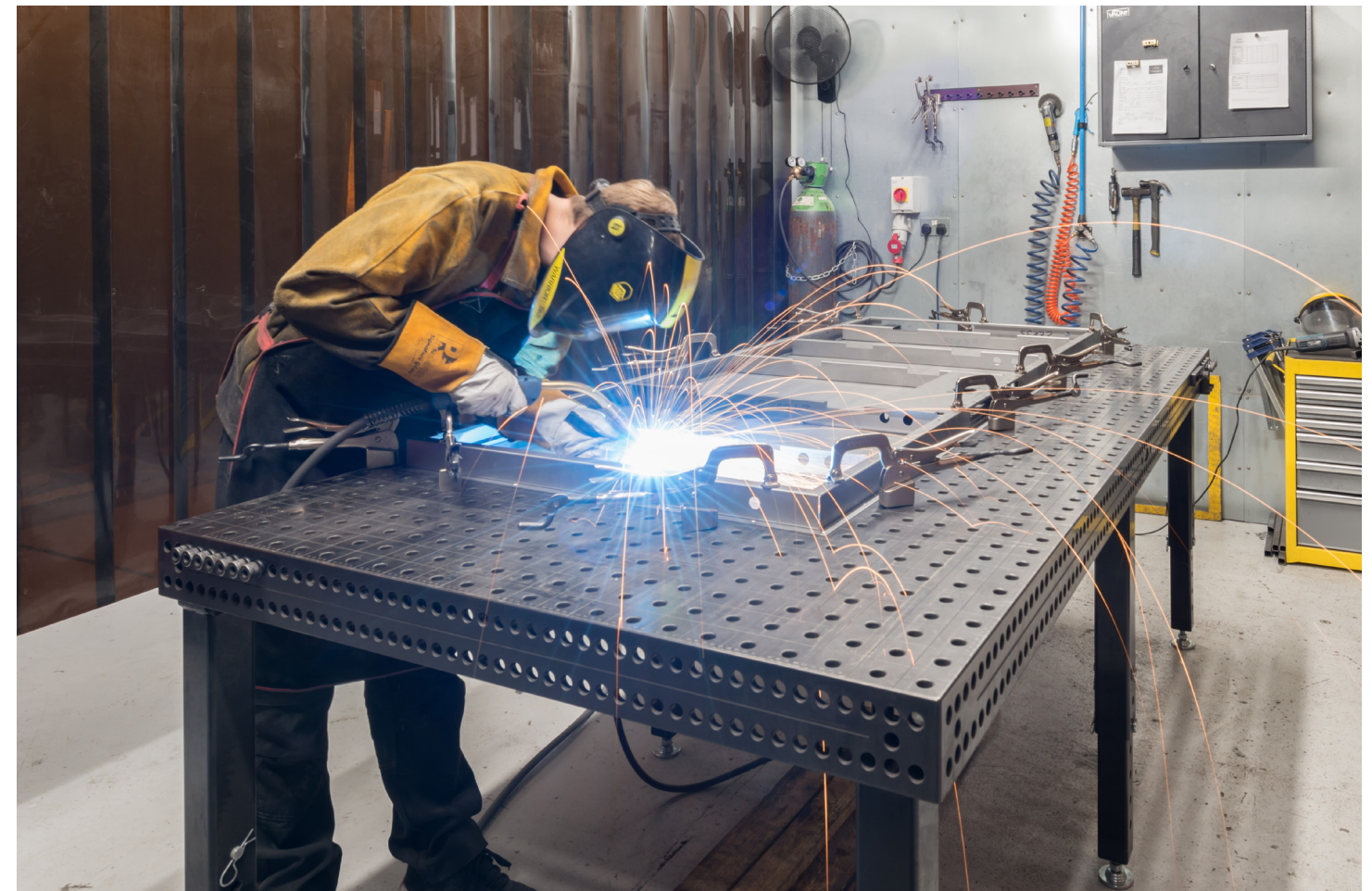
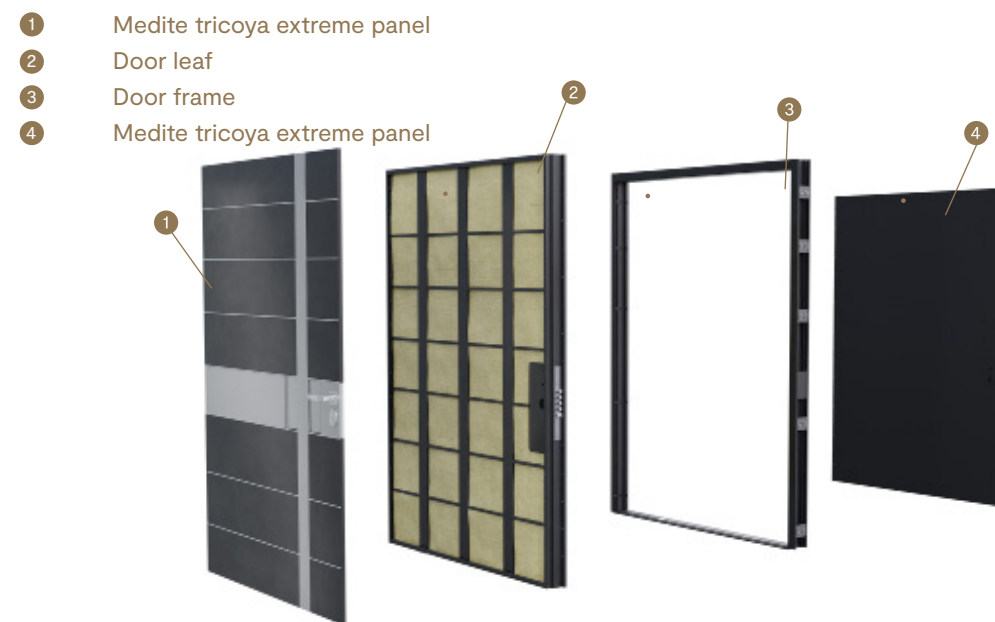
If you are looking for the ultimate grand design, a pivot door will certainly create an outstanding entrance. The construction and materials are the same as our hinged steel doors, but the door opens by rotating from an ultra-strong vertical pivot at the top and bottom of the door. The pivot system allows for a very large opening up to 3000mm high x 2000mm wide, and comes with a drop down seal

to ensure the opening is weather tight when closed. In addition, advanced entry features are available such as a fingerprint scanner. Pivot doors can accommodate any contemporary design due to the flat surface area which can sit completely flush to the wall. Just like our hinged doors, you can also choose a different design and finish on the inside if you wish.

Made to Measure

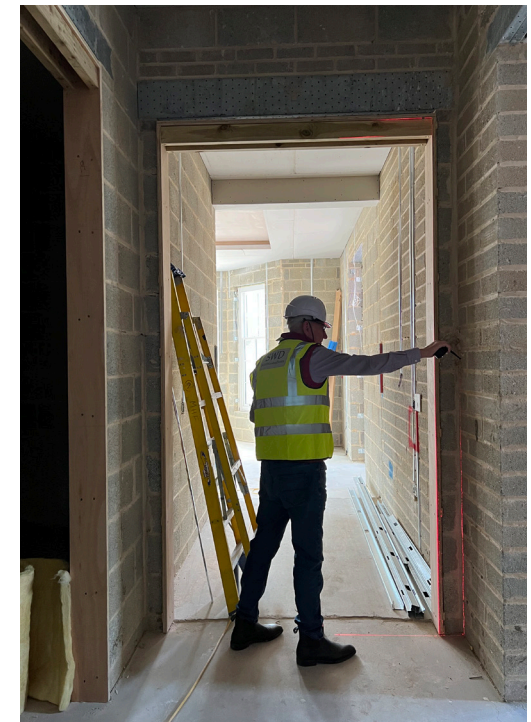
